Williamson County Contractor Workshop 2/11/16

1) Program Overview

- a) GEC role – HNTB is GEC (General Engineering Consultant) for program, manages multiple design firms preparing plans for Wilco construction projects, and contractors performing construction. Referenced as Construction Observer/Construction Representative.
- b) Design consultant role – contracted to design individual projects for the County. They are the Engineer of Record

2) Bidding procedures

- a) On-line bidding procedures – County is utilizing Bid Sync for on line letting. Go to BIDSINC.com. They will still accept hard copies, but highly discourage hard copies. Handouts supplied.

3) QC/QA Program

- a) Contractor role – contractor is required to have a QC Program. QC is part of the County Acceptance Program. Contractor QC testing must be done by a qualified lab/person. Sampling and testing done in accordance with Sampling and Testing Guide in the Manual. Results must meet minimum requirements as outlined in the contract. TxDOT Specifications are adopted for use on County projects.
- b) GEC role – responsible for acceptance and verification testing. QC and QA are part of the County Acceptance program. QA testing performed by qualified lab/person and sampled at approximately 10% of QC testing.

4) Contract requirements

- a) Maintenance Bond – County requires a two year maintenance bond on all projects let by the County on the County system. This is an all inclusive maintenance bond for two years from issuance of “ Date of Completion”

5) 2016 letting schedule

- a) Approximately 25 projects
- b) Totalling approximately \$125 M
